By now we hope you've seen the wonderful, hand-painted banners from the 2008 competition flying from the lamp posts on Main Street in Colfax. If you haven't, look for them at the 2008 Hullabaloo in October, then in their winter home at Rosauer's.

We're doing it again in 2009, so now is your chance to have your art seen every day by thousands of drivers from all over!

H'Art of the Palouse is a juried art competition sponsored by the Colfax Arts Council to bring original works of art to the heart of Whitman County—Colfax's downtown Main Street. The top designs submitted will be painted by the winning artists on banners provided by the Arts Council and displayed through the spring and summer of 2009.

So all you creative folks, this is the time to make a painting and be in the most widely viewed art exhibit around!

★ How to enter

Using 11 x 17 material as a base—paper, card board, or similar material—create a scale representation of your design sized to 7 1/2" wide x 15" high, in color, using colored pencils, paint, markers—your favorite sketching tools. Be as accurate as possible to indicate your design and colors. If your design is chosen, it will be expected that you can render it in acrylic paints on a full size, blank banner provided to you by the Colfax Arts Council.

Words are not required, but if you choose to include words, the letters must be at least 3 - 4 inches high on the final banner, or about 3/4 - 1 inch on your sketch.

Fill out the entry form on the back of this flyer and attach it with tape to the BACK of your design. Do not sign the front of your sketch. If your design is chosen, you will have the opportunity to sign your banner.

Entries will not be returned, so you may enter a color copy of your design as long as it accurately represents your colors, is to the proper scale, and is on 11 x 17 paper.

You may submit more than one entry.

★ The theme is "The Palouse Country"

This year we only scratched the surface of this theme, so we've decided to keep it the same for next year. Anything you can think of that exemplifies life on the Palouse is open for consideration. You could choose a favorite historical person, item or event; a landscape; native plants; a season; or a completely abstract idea about any aspect of life on the Palouse. Anything! These are just ideas to get you started. The creative field is wide open to any style, any colors, as long as you can render it in acrylic paints on a vinyl banner if your design is chosen as a winner. Think big and bold!

★ Who is eligible

Absolutely everyone, including Uncle Milo who lives in Detroit. Kids, grown ups, professional and closet artists, teachers and students. Encourage everyone you know to enter. If you think you can't paint, get your artist friend to render your idea!

Wednesday, November 5, 2008, or anytime before!

🌟 **Where to send or deliver entries**

Mail along with your entry form and fee, early enough that it will be received on or before November 5 to:

+ Colfax Arts Council at the address on the form

In person, deliver on or before November 5 to:

+ Whitman County Library in Colfax or

+ Port of Whitman office in Colfax, address on the form

🌟 **Then what happens**

The entries will be juried by an esteemed panel of judges made up of regional artists and representatives from the City of Colfax and civic organizations. Entries received after November 5 will not be considered and the decisions of the judges will be final.

Winners will be notified on or before November 13, 2008.

On Saturday, November 15, 2008 we will hold a workshop for the winners – to provide technical input and answer questions – and we'll hand out the blank white vinyl banners, 30 x 60 inches in size. Each artist will paint his or her design with acrylic paints – artist's colors and/or exterior latex house paint. Thus, each banner will be an original painting.

Completed painted banners will be due back to the Colfax Arts Council by Friday, January 16, 2009.

Banners will be hung on Sunday, February 22, 2009. They will be up through early October 2009.

🌟 **H'Art of the Palouse Reception**

On Thursday, March 5, 2009 the Colfax Arts Council will host a reception for the artists and all who entered the competition. Details to be announced.

🌟 **People's Choice Award**

The public will have a chance to vote for their favorite banner prior to the H'Art of the Palouse Reception and the artist chosen from the finalists will be given a People's Choice Award during the reception. The actual prize will also be created by "the people," with a donation jar prominently located in town to collect everything from cash and gift certificates, to art supplies and.... We won't know what it is till it's awarded (but we can tell you that the 2008 Award included over \$250 in cash and gift certificates, and lots of other curiosities and items of artistic interest including a few art supplies!)
